children in Year 4. Children in Year 3 need to remember to bring water soakers on the day – as they are allowed to get the Year 4 children as wet as possible!


Please can all parents remember that **sunhats and sunscreen** for their children are a necessity as they will be outside all morning and the weather is looking as though it may be rather warm!!
