



- Read a wide range of books to your child and ask them questions such as 'What do you think will happen next?' 'Why did the character feel like that?'
- Help your child to practise spelling the Year 1 common exception words.
- Practise mental oral maths skills with your child e.g. counting to 100 (and beyond) - forwards, backwards and from different starting points, quick recall of number facts within 20 (e.g. 6 + 7, 13-5)
- Playing phonic games to help with reading e.g. http://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/BuriedTreasure2.ht **ml** (Phase 5 - use only the free resources)
- Help your child to recognise common wild and garden plants and trees e.g. daffodils, tulips, snowdrops, carrots, strawberries, oak tree, fruit tree. Also, to understand the words 'deciduous' and 'evergreen'.
- Help your child to know which is their left and right hand and to be able to turn left and right.


