

Dear Parents,

As part of P.E Week we are delighted to advise parents that on **Wednesday 21st March** all children in school will be visiting Weymouth Outdoor Education Centre (WOEC) and taking part in different activities, including the traverse climbing wall.

The Reception Class, Year 1 and half of Year 2 will be at the WOEC from 10am – 12.30pm and the other half of Year 2 and Years 3 and 4 will there from 1.30 – 4pm. We anticipate that the children attending the afternoon session will be back at Frome Valley around 4.30pm. Children in Year 2 will be advised in a separate note, which session they will be attending.

On the day children will need to wear a suitable warm P.E kit with trainers. (This can be worn to school for the day). Please can parents also ensure that ant long hair is securely tied back.

For the day all hot meals have been cancelled. All children need to bring with them a named disposable lunch with lots of healthy snacks. If your child is in the Reception Class, Year 1 and Year 2 you have the option of providing your own lunch or ordering an away day packed lunch (part of universal free meals). If your child is in Years 3 and 4 and entitled to free school meals, again you have the option of providing your own lunch or ordering an away day lunch.

The current away day lunch consists of a cheese roll, cake or cookie of the day, a raisin and sultana fruit bag and a bottle of water

Please note that if you wish for us to order an away day lunch from Chartwells, we need you to return the below form by Tuesday 6th March at the latest .

Children will be travelling to and from the WOEC by either mini bus or coach. We are asking parents for a contribution of £2 towards the cost of this with all other fees being paid for by school.

We are looking for a couple of parent helpers to help with the visit. If you are free, please speak to class teachers as soon as possible.
