Welcome to the June edition of the Preschool newsletter and the final half term for this academic year.

With the warmer weather comes lots of outdoor fun activities with the favourite always being those that involve water.

Can we please ask parents to ensure their child has a complete change of clothes, including shoes, in case they get a little too wet! We endeavour to sun dry wet clothes before sending them home but we apologise if this does not always happen.

FUN IN THE SUN

You may have noticed that we take our responsibility for the children's welfare in the sun very seriously and insist they wear hats and have sun cream applied.

The children are incredibly good at putting on their hats before going outside and will automatically find a Preschool hat to wear if they have forgotten their own.

On hot, sunny days when parents sign their child in we will now ask that you also sign a sun cream sheet to indicate that your child has had cream applied and, as importantly, the period of protection that the cream provides. i.e. 4 or 8 hour. Children with 4 hour protection will have cream reapplied by staff before they go outside in the afternoon.

Can we please ask parents to place their child's named sun cream in the red basket provided.

TRIP TO FARMER PALMERS

We suggest that parents/carers and children wait on the school field until the coach arrives at 9.15am and we will aim to leave school at 9.30am. Children that are being looked after by a member of staff can be brought in to Preschool at 9am as usual.

The coach does have seat belts and parents may wish to bring booster seats for their child. Please be advised though, the coach seats are very narrow.

PRESCHOOL SPORTS DAY

On Tuesday 13th June at 9.15am (Wednesday 14th, if wet on 13th) we will be holding on the school field our Preschool Sports day.

The children have been practicing very hard and like the Summer trip, all preschool children, regardless if this is their usual day to attend preschool or not, are encouraged to come along. We would also like to invite all parents, younger siblings, grandparents and other carers to come to cheer them all on.

We ask that all children are bought into the preschool room first as normal at 9.00am and are signed in. We will ensure they all go to the toilet and are wearing a sun hat and then we will bring out all the children together to the school field where we will be having our races.

All preschool children will be encouraged to remain with staff and take part in the races. At the end of the races refreshments will be served, which will include coffee and cake, and ice-creams for the children.

For those coming to watch that may need to go back to work the sports day usually lasts for about an hour.

PRESCHOOL FEES
