COVID-19 Update

Over the past week, we have had a number of positive cases of pupils and staff and we currently have two children isolating. Both children are asymptomatic and have been confirmed by regular lateral flow testing. Please continue to test your child twice a week with a LFT. For close contacts of cases in school, **you should test you child daily for 7 days.**

Please be aware that with the Omicron variant it appears that some of the symptoms may include: runny nose, headache, fatigue, sneezing and a sore throat.

Once more, a reminder to everyone **that a PCR test is still needed if any child has any of the three main symptoms:**

A fever / high temperature (temperature above 37.8)

A new, continuous cough

A loss or change to sense of smell or taste

If your child has any of the above symptoms, they will still need to isolate until a negative PCR result has been received. Thank you for your help in keeping all of us safe, fit, well and in school.
