After School Science – Thursdays


The after school science club is full. Please note that this club finishes at the slightly earlier time of **4.15pm**

Summer Weather!!

A few reminders to parents now we are in the summer term and will hopefully have lots of sunshine! Please can parents ensure that their children have in school **a named sun hat** and that, if the weather is warm, **they have sunscreen applied before school**. We recommend that parents apply a long lasting sun cream rather than reapplying during the school day. If this is not possible, please ensure that all bottles that come to school are named. **Please be advised that children will need to apply the cream themselves.** For safety reasons, please remember that children need to continue to wear suitable school footwear. **Flip flops, sandals, trainers and croc style shoes** are not allowed in school. This needs to be adhered to on non-uniform days as well please (though trainers are allowed on non-uniform days).
