Please make your picnic as environmentally friendly as possible – try to avoid single use plastics and see if you can include some plant based food!

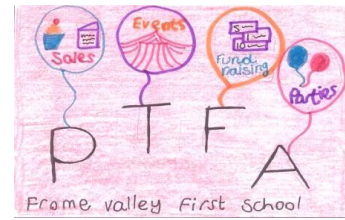
*In case of bad weather – we will raise the flag at 3pm just before home time and cancel the picnic.*
