PTFA News

Make supporting our lottery your New Year's Resolution! We unfortunately now only have 20 supporters (staff and parents) keeping our school lottery afloat. Donating £1 a week can make a real difference! Also, register and buy a ticket this half term and you could win a holiday to Cornwall in a luxury cabin with Forest Holidays worth £500! Here's a reminder of what it's all about.



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Tickets for the lottery cost just £1 per week, with a top prize of £25,000! Each ticket will consist of 6 numbers and each number will be between 0 and 9. There will be a draw every Saturday night when a 6 digit winning combination will be picked. Match all 6 and you win the JACKPOT! There is also a guaranteed Frome Valley winner every Saturday which is drawn on a raffle basis, so there are two chances to win a prize. Signing up is easy. You just need to give your name, email address, and postal address plus date of birth to validate you are over 16. You can either set up a monthly recurring payment plan via Direct Debit or payment card OR pay for a block of 1, 3, 6 or 12 months of weekly tickets on a non-recurring basis. There is no commitment to stay in the lottery and you can choose to leave at any time. You can't just buy a ticket for a single week due to processing charges unfortunately so the minimum you can pay is £4 (£1 a week for a month). The PTFA gets 40p per £1 ticket and another 36p goes into the school's prize pot.

Reception Class Vision Screening - Wednesday 9th February

Dorset Vision Screening Service will be in school on **Wednesday 9th February** to assess the vision of children in the Reception class. This check is recommended in order to pick up undetected, treatable vision problems in your child's first year at school. The assessment only takes a few minutes, and will involve measuring your child's vision with each eye in turn using a simple letter matching test. If there are any concerns from this assessment, your child will be offered an appointment at their nearest hospital eye department for further investigation.

For your child to be assessed parents need to register on a secure portal for Dorset Vision Screening Service. The link to this is:
