

Year 1 Phonics Parent Information Session



Dear Year 1 Parents,

Over the last few years there have been numerous interruptions to your child's education, from 2 lockdowns to children missing a lot of education through covid-19 related illnesses and absences. All this has taken its toll on your child's education, especially in your child's phonics development.

Phonics is the foundation of reading, writing and spelling and we therefore need your help in Year 1 to support your child's phonics development, <u>particularly your child's blending skills in phonics</u>.

We are asking **ALL PARENTS** to attend a short information session on **Monday 31**st **January**, **straight after school, in the hall**. At this session, we will discuss how blending is taught in Year 1 and what you can do at home to support your child's blending skills. We will also give out a phonics resource pack that you can use at home with your child. This pack will include some simple games and activities that you can work on, **5-10 minutes**, **3 times per week**, to really help your child improve his/her phonic skills.

We cannot stress the importance of you attending this meeting and of us needing your support in helping your child's progress in phonics.
