Science Week

Do you use science? If so, we need your help!

During science week (5-8 February 2024), we want to introduce our children to a range of people who work in science-related jobs, or who use science on a daily basis.

Science includes working in or with:

Agriculture, animals, medicines, health and hygiene, food, transportation, communication, construction, engineering, product design, water systems, plants, sound and music, and so much more...

You can help in many different ways, such as:

- Coming into school to talk to a class or the whole school,
- Making and sending us a short 4-5 minute film clip,
- Preparing a few digital photographs with an explanation of how science is useful to you.

What are we learning in our classrooms this week?

Reception	Year 1	Year 2	Year 3	Year 4
Our topic this half term is 'Traditional Tales'. We will be creating a story map for 'The Three Little Pigs' and then acting out the story with our friends.	We will be recognising what makes a sentence and then editing sentences that have been written incorrectly.	In literacy, we will continue to look at word classes, moving onto learning about verbs and adverbs.	In Literacy, we are learning to edit and improve our own writing.	In Literacy we are starting to read the Butterfly Lion.
We are learning about 'zero' and spotting what zero looks like in difference places.	We will be focusing on subtraction - using crossing out as a strategy and also working out 'how many are left?'. In Geography, we are going to look at the four countries in the UK.	In numeracy, we will be looking at money, identifying notes and coins.	In Numeracy, we are learning about the importance of equal groups when multiplying.	In numeracy we are going to look at factor pairs, and to learn how many factors each number has.
In PE, we are learning the skill of a 'seated balance' - sitting on our bottoms and then trying to lift our hands, feet and legs off the floor and holding the position for 10 seconds.		In art, we will be exploring food art by Giuseppe Arcimboldo and planning printing on textiles.	In Design and Technology, we are learning about machines that use pneumatics or hydraulics.	In PE we are going to do Forest Schools and learn about how to respect nature.
