ADDITIONAL FUNDING (30 hours)

You can now apply for your additional funding for the spring term.

Working parents who are or hope to access additional funding for their child in the spring term must have applied for and been given an eligibility code that is dated by **31st DECEMBER** Any codes dated after this date **WILL NOT** be able to be used until the Spring term.

Parents already accessing this funding should be aware that the eligibility codes are valid for only 3 months and it is a parents responsibility to ensure they check the codes are still eligible. It is very important to do so as although there will be a grace period if you do not re-apply in time, they will withdraw your funding in the end.

If you want to find out more about this funding or are unsure how to check your code is still valid please talk to Gemma.

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

You can now apply for your child's school place online at https://www.dorsetforyou.gov.uk/school-admissions.

The cut off date for applications is 15th January 2019 and these places will be released on 16th April 2018. Any applications received after 15th January 2018 will be considered a late application and the outcome will not be released until further on in the year, so it is important that you submit your application sooner rather than later. DRESS FOR MESS.

Within preschool we do use a lot of messy and exciting play for the children to experience and although aprons will be available to use, we feel it is really important to your child's learning that they are able to access such activities freely and confidently, so please ensure you child is "dressed for mess" so that we do not hinder their experiences and learning opportunities.

WHAT WE ARE DOING.

This month we will be settling into preschool life and learning the rules and routines of how preschool works. We will also be looking at the topic of 'all about me'. We will be looking at what makes us the same, similar and different, for example eye and hair colour. Looking at the different places where people live and who shares our home with us.

WHAT YOU CAN ENCOURAGE AT HOME

To encourage settling in to preschool, you can read stories about starting school and talking to your child about what they have done at preschool.
