Community Litter Pick

The day will start with our annual community litter pick.

We need lots of helpers for this activity so please speak to your child's class teacher if you can help. Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will be starting straight away at 8:50. *These classes* will be litter picking in areas around School Drive, the playing fields and around the school area. Year 3 and Year 4 will start at 9:45am. Their focus will be up to and around the post office. If you know of any areas that have a particular problem with litter, please let Mrs Duerdoth know. Adults and children will all be provided with the appropriate safety gear.

Enough **plastic** is thrown away each year to circle the Earth four times.

Beeswax Cotton Wraps
