### **New DfE Guidelines**

Parents may have seen in the news that the DfE advice to schools is that all restrictions of bubbles, face masks etc will be lifted for the new academic year. Before the end of term, we will be writing to parents to let them know what drop offs and pickups will look like in September.

However, please note that schools have been advised to keep to their bubbles for the rest of the summer term. We will also be continuing with our current staggered drop offs and pickups and restricting access to the school building.

From Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July, it will no longer be a requirement to wear a face mask, when you are on school grounds, unless you wish to do so.
