Year 3 are visiting Dorchester Museum on Thursday 23rd June. Please can all permission slips and payments be made as soon as possible. Thank you.

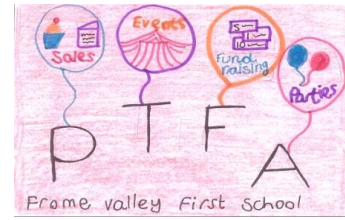
Reception Class trip to Moors Valley
