TerraCycle - New Recycling Scheme

We are delighted to announce that we have been accepted in a new recycling scheme through TerraCycle. TerraCycle are helping us to eliminate the idea of waste and raise funds for school at the same time.

The two collections we are taking part in are:

Writing Instrument Recycling: We accept any brand of pen, felt tip, highlighter, marker, correction fluid pot, correction tape, mechanical pencil and eraser pen (cap included) regardless of their composition (plastic, metal).

Pladis Biscuit and Snack Recycling: We accept any brand of cracker wrappers and non-savoury biscuit wrappers such as digestives, rich tea etc. This includes the likes of Penguin's etc but not chocolate bars like Mars, Snickers etc, or the inside plastic tray as they are made from a different material.

We have attached a poster that gives full information on acceptable products. By the end of the week, we will have boxes located near the office for all your items. We are happy to accept items from the wider community, so please let others know.
