## Transfer Day - Thursday 1st July

This **Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> July** is transfer day. Unfortunately, due to current restrictions, Year 4 are unable to spend the day at St Marys Middle School. They will be visiting the school at a different time. On Thursday, Reception – Year 3 will be spending the day in their new classroom with their new class teacher. For this day only, **we need children to be dropped off and picked up at the timings of their new class for the day and via the appropriate entrance.** For example if your child is currently in the Reception class but will be in Year 1 in September, you will need to follow the Year 1 timings etc.. below.

	Drop off time	Pick up time	Entrance
Year 1	8.40-8.50	3.10-3.20	The normal double doors from the playground.
Year 2	8.30-8.40	3.20-3.30	The normal double doors from the playground.
Year 3	8.40-8.50	3.10-3.20	The Year 3&4 double doors by Year 4.
Year 4	8.30-8.40	3.20-3.30	The Year 3&4 double doors by Year 4.

Please can current Year 4 arrive between 8.30 – 8.40am and be picked up from 3.20 – 3.30pm (usual times) but their entrance for the day will be the doors to the hall accessible from the playground.
