Reception Class – All of the Reception class are animals. They need to wear black bottoms and a plain black top. They will be given an animal headdress to wear.

Year 1 Girls – All girls are suffragettes. They need to wear a long skirt with a blouse or a plain dress.

Year 1 Boys – All boys are business men. They need to dress smartly in trousers, shirt and a tie. If they have a jacket or waistcoat that can also be worn.
