COVID-19 Update

Thank you to everyone that is continuing to complete lateral flow tests regularly on their children. We currently have one child and one member of staff isolating.

Please can we remind everyone that a PCR test is still needed if any child has any of the three main symptoms:

A fever / high temperature (temperature above 37.8)

A new, continuous cough

A loss or change to sense of smell or taste

If your child has any of the above symptoms, they will still need to isolate until a negative <u>PCR result has been received.</u> Thank you for your help in keeping all of us safe, fit, well and in school.

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Parent Drop In - Thursday 27th January

The first of this year's drop in sessions is this **Thursday 27**th **January**. To keep everyone safe we are asking parents to adhere to the following protocol:

We would like all parents to take a LFD (lateral flow test) before coming into school and wear a mask at all times. In order to limit the number of people in school, we ask that one parent only attends. If possible, it would be good if younger siblings were not at Drop-Ins too.

Parents will be able to speak to the class teacher and look at their child's work. Teachers can discuss your child's next step in their learning and how you can support your child at home. You can drop in at any time during this session and the class teachers look forward to seeing you there.

There is an early morning session from **8.15 – 8.40am** and an afternoon session from **2.15 – 3pm**.

There are often many parents that would like to speak to the teacher so we ask that parents write their name on the whiteboard in the classroom as they arrive. Teachers will then speak to parents in order of their arrival!
