SchoolComms

A quick reminder to all parents that we use SchoolComms for all bookings of clubs and also payments for school trips etc.

If you have not yet registered, please do so as soon as possible.

The first thing we need parents to do is download the SchoolComms app.

Just to confuse things slightly it is called Schoolgateway.

You need to register with the email address and mobile phone number that we hold on file for you.

The below are instructions from the company.

- 1. Download the Android or iPhone app.
- 2. Press Sign Up then enter the email and mobile number your school has on record. If you're not sure if they have the right details, it's best to check and update first.
- 3. Press Send PIN. You will receive a text message with your unique PIN.
- 4. You're now ready to log in and start using School Gateway
