Alison has asked us to remind all parents that the only place you can ride a privately owned e-scooter is on private land with the landowner's permission. It is against the law to ride an e-scooter on any public land. This includes pavements, cycle lanes, beach promenades, bridleways, or any publicly accessible land such as parks and car parks. 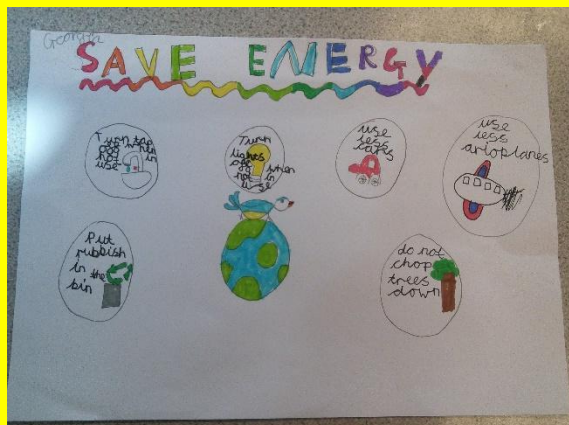
