



- Listen to your child read as often as possible and read to them too! Ask your children to predict what might happen next and also to infer answers that are not specifically given e.g. How did she feel? She was scared because it said 'her tummy had butterflies'.
- Practise number bonds to 10 with your child e.g. 5 + 3 = 8, 8 - 5 = 3, 7 + 3 = 10. Some useful websites to help with this are: https://www.bbc.co.uk/sport/av/supermovers

Year 2 Curriculum Overview

Reading

- To re-read books to build up fluency and confidence.
- To read words containing common suffixes.
- To read longer words with more than 2 syllables.
- To predict what might happen next in a story.
- To infer.

English

Writing

- To write sentences for different purposes e.g. using either storytelling, or instructional language.
- To use words such as when, next, meanwhile, because, and, or but.
- To continue to work on using punctuation correctly in writing, including exclamation and question marks.

Phonics

- To continue practise recognition and recall of learnt graphemes.
- To apply learnt spellings to independent written work.
- To learn to spell days of the week, months and numbers to one hundred.

Maths

- To count forwards and backwards to 100 in 2s. 3s, 5s and 10s.
- To know number bonds within 100 e.g. 2 + 8 = 10, 12 + 8 = 20
- To add 3 numbers together.
- To add and subtract two digit numbers and record answers in a formal way.
- To know the 2.5 and 10 times tables.
- To solve multiplication and division problems using times table facts and objects or pictures.

- To identify lines of symmetry.
- To read the time to o'clock and half past.
- To read the time to 5 minute intervals

History

- To know how materials are made and where they come from.
- To identify and compare how suitable materials are for certain jobs.
