World Book Day and Stories at 6



In Literacy, we will be revisiting rhyming words and making 'rhyming silly soup' to practice continuing a rhyming string. E.g. dog, log, frog, bog.	In Literacy, we are focusing on exclamation marks for single words that show a strong emotion and for commands e.g. Wow! Sit down!
