Gift Aid is an income tax relief designed to benefit charities, such as the PTFA. If you're a UK taxpayer, Gift Aid increases the value of your charity donations by 25% because the charity can reclaim the basic rate of tax on your gift – at no extra cost to you. So for every £1 you contribute to events such as school discos or when you sponsor your child for the '1000 Flip Challenge', the PTFA can claim an extra 25p...which will really add up over the year.
