Textile Recycling

A reminder that, this week, we are collecting 'Textile Recycling'. The more we collect in weight the more funds we raise for school.

Accepted textiles include:

- Men's, Ladies and Children's clothing
- Paired shoes (tied together or elastic band around)
- Handbags
- Hats
- Bags
- Scarves and ties
- Jewellery
- Belts
- Soft toys

Household linen, curtains, towels, bedding (bed sheets, pillow cases and duvet covers).

Please note that these items are also acceptable – even though it says No on the bag!!

We are accepting items in school from today until 9am on Friday 1st February. If you would like another bag, please ask!
