



Dear Parents,

Year 4 will be visiting the Nothe Fort in Weymouth on **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February** as part of their World War II History curriculum. While there, each child will take part in 5 different activities: Weymouth at War, Shopping and ration books, Washing, Air raid precautions and School.

**To add to the experience children are asked to dress as evacuees and bring a home made gas mask box and a small teddy bear.**

They also need a warm jacket to wear over their outfit as some of the activities are outside. Please see separate sheets with ideas for costumes and gas mask boxes. Alternatively, please speak to Mrs Essex.

We shall be leaving school at 9.15am and will return for 3.15pm. Children will need a named disposable lunch, a snack and lots to drink, which all need to be in a small rucksack.

If your child is entitled to a free school meal we are able to order an away day lunch. The lunch from Local food Links consists of: Filled roll (cheese, tuna mayo or ham), a piece of fruit, lentil waves, homemade flapjack. **You will need to provide a drink.**

The cost of this trip is £12.00 per child. This is made up of the entrance fee of £4.00 per child and an equal share of the transport costs.
