Applications need to be received by 1st July in order to guarantee lessons starting in September.

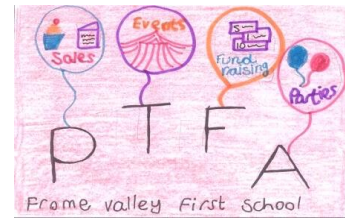
In addition, we also have a variety of ensembles available for children in first schools including our Stringalings beginner string group, Bandamonium beginner windband and Skylarks Choir.
