Celebration Assembly

A reminder to parents that Celebration Assemblies take place on the following dates.

Reception, Years 1 and 2 – Tuesday 28th June 2.15pm
Years 3 and 4 – Wednesday 29th June 2.30pm



All are welcome to this very special assembly, which will take place in the school hall.

At Celebration Assembly, we celebrate achievements outside and inside the school. We will celebrate children that have completed their WOW cards and will also celebrate the DASP citizens.

Two children from each class (Reception to Year 4) will be presented with progress cups for the year and two children from each class will be presented with hard work cups for all their hard work this year in their learning.

There will also be two special trophies presented: The Citizenship Cup (for a Year 4 child that has been an outstanding citizen throughout his/her time at Frome Valley) and the Outstanding Achievement Cup. Again, this is given to a child in Year 4 that has achieved outstanding progress and attainment throughout his/her time at Frome Valley School.

There will also be two trophies for two children that have particularly lived out our school values of compassion, respect and perseverance throughout this year.

Please remember that if your child has been awarded any certificates outside of school, please bring them to the school office so that their achievements can also be recognised.

School Play – Jungle Book

The school play is only a couple of weeks away!! Please find below some important information for all parents.

All the children in school take part in the play, with each class having their chance to shine on the stage through a dance. We expect that all children in school will attend every performance (**Wednesday 13th July at 6pm, Friday 15th July at 6pm and Monday 18th July at 6pm**). Children in the Reception class and Year 1 will be able to leave at the interval. We will let parents know an estimated time for this after the dress rehearsal next Friday.

Costumes – Reception, Years 1, 2 and 3

All children in the Reception class, Years 1, 2 and 3 are jungle animals. We have a mask for every child but they need to wear **jungle coloured** clothing. Preferably all one colour, e.g. all in black, all in green, all in yellow or all in red.

Dress rehearsal Days

On Friday 8th July, Years 2 – 4 only will be at the village hall for the dress rehearsal. They will walk there with school staff at the beginning of the school day. Children in Years 2 & 3 will need to wear their costume to school and bring their school uniform in a bag to change into on return to school. Year 4 will have their costumes at the village hall to change into. All children will return to school by lunchtime.

On Monday 11th July, we are back at the village hall to practise all songs and dances on the stage during the morning. **We would like all children to be dropped off at the village hall between 8.40 – 8.50am.** Children in breakfast club will be walked down by a member of staff. On this day, children will just need to wear their school uniform.

Book donations still needed

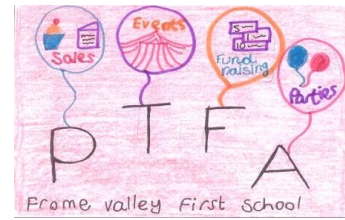
We're still looking for quality, nearly-new children's book donations for the new library. Just hand them to your child's class teacher.
